

Remembering Professor Aditya Chattopadhyay



Members of IAPQR express their grief and profound sorrow on the unexpected and untimely passing away of **Professor Aditya Chattopadhyay**, a senior Professor of Statistics, University of Calcutta, and a dedicated member of IAPQR. He breathed his last in the early hours of Saturday, April 24, 2021. He was 63, and is survived by his wife and daughter.

Professor Chattopadhyay was a perfect gentleman, a brilliant student and a reputed researcher. In the early years of his career he taught in the Department of Statistics, Burdwan University and then joined the Department of Statistics, University of Calcutta in the year 2009.

His contributions in the areas of Reliability, Biostatistics and Statistical Data Analysis will be remembered with admiration.

Besides his brilliance in academics, Professor Chattopadhyay was an esteemed member of the Board of Governors of IAPQR, a premier organisation for promoting the study of Statistics. He shouldered several responsibilities in the organization of IAPQR Conferences.

Professor Chattopadhyay was a great teacher, who was loved and admired by his students and colleagues. He was always genuinely interested in the activities of IAPQR and supported in a proactive manner, contributing much to its international visibility.

He was an amicable person and with humble and friendly behavior with a warm bonding with colleagues, students, friends and colleagues. IAPQR will always miss him as a committed functionary, an impressive teacher and an excellent human being.
